PURPOSE

Saskatchewan Polytechnic sets forth a Student Code of Conduct (Academic) that aligns with its core values and upholds the highest levels of academic integrity. Academic misconduct is conduct which undermines academic integrity by using illegitimate or dishonest means in order to achieve academic success.

POLICY

Saskatchewan Polytechnic students have a responsibility to act ethically, honestly, and in a manner that upholds academic integrity on all academic matters. The Student Code of Conduct (Academic) provides the framework for addressing cases where students fail to conduct themselves in this manner.

DEFINITION

Academic misconduct is conduct which undermines academic integrity by using illegitimate or dishonest means in order to achieve academic success. Acts of academic misconduct may create an unfair academic advantage for the student who committed the violation and compromise Saskatchewan Polytechnic's ability to assess a student's academic achievements. Violations include but are not limited to plagiarism, cheating, falsification of documents, impersonation, misrepresentation, and procurement.
